What is HVO as a fuel?



HVO is 100% fossil fuel free.



HVO is a **clear liquid** that is part of the paraffinic family.



HVO fuel carries **International Sustainability** and **Carbon Certification** (ISCC), which is an independent certification system that rates various fuels based on their environmental effects. This means that HVO meets the minimum environmental, traceability, and social requirements.



HVO is also **fully biodegradable**, which means that in the event of a leak or a spillage of this fuel, any potential environmental damage will be minimal. HVO fuel is **compliant** with the EU REACH regulations under the OECD test guideline 301 B, which is another point in favour of its biodegradability.



The crops used in manufacturing HVO fuel **do not damage the environment** or the ecosystem. This makes HVO fuel a very **attractive alternative** for homeowners and companies that are seeking to go green.



HVO is produced from waste, residue oils and fats.

How does it work in your heating system

- Drop in replacement for Kerosene, so order from your normal fuel suppliers.
- Has a 10 year extended storage lifespan in your tank.
- Max €400 upgrade cost to your boiler required.

Results

- 90% **reduction** in your GHG (Greenhouse Gas) emissions.
- On average an annual reduction of up to 6 tons of CO2 per household.
- Boiler's **high-efficiency** is maintained.
- HVO is kinder to the boiler with less deterioration over time.
